My understanding was that Mr. Foltz would be pursuing both the Army Corps and the HPA from Fish & Wildlife. I recommend moving forward with that application, though as I read our code below, having the HPA is required prior to building permit submittal.

Attached, you'll find our signed SEPA determination. This is required in moving forward with an application for an HPA (Hydraulic Permit Approval) from the WDFW (Washington State Department of Fish & Wildlife). In the past, the JARPA was used for both the Army Corps permit and the HPA. Now, I believe WDFW has streamlined their process. Their application
