I live three houses from the proposed pump station. I have concerns about the noise from the pump station and the traffic in the neighborhood. The gate that is at the entrance to the 18460 property now gives that part of the street an industrial appearance with warnings and no trespassing signs. I am concerned that further development of that property will result in an even more industrial appearance that is not in keeping with the residential nature of this street. If there is an office on the top of the pump house I am wondering if there will be additional traffic and noise. I love having the great water in LFP and realize that upgrades must be made to maintain the quality of the water but believe every effort must be made to maintain the residential nature of this neighborhood.
