Approved Proposal: Installation of residential gas service. The proposal includes one 3' x 5' bore pit within the right-of-way, and installation of a 1-1/8" PE gas service line to the existing house. The location of work is within the 200 foot buffer from Lake Washington. Therefore, approval of this proposal was subject to Shoreline Master Program standards. All work must employ best management practices and be consistent with the policies and provisions of LFP Shoreline Master Program and the Shoreline Management Act. A right-of-way permit is also required in order to undertake this project.


