**Subject: Sanitary Sewer Extension Phase 3 – Construction Notification**

Dear Lake Forest Park Resident:

As you may know, the City has been working in the last year on a project to extend sanitary sewer service to your neighborhood. The project has been designed, a contract for construction has been executed and construction is ready to begin. The anticipated construction start date is August 4, 2008 and construction is expected to last until the end of October 2008.

During the construction period, traffic on 40<sup>th</sup> Place NE in the construction zone will be limited to "Local Access Only." This means residents will be able to drive to and from their homes but it will not be possible under most conditions to drive through the project. Normal passage of school buses will be accommodated as well as access for emergency vehicles. In the event that construction activity from time to time necessitates the temporary closure of individual driveways, residents will be notified at least 24 hours in advance. The City will endeavor to minimize the inconvenience to residents during the construction period.
