CALL TO ORDER

Deputy Mayor Kassover called the July 19, 2021 Committee of the Whole meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Kassover noted that the proposed ordinance on the plastic bag will be taken out of order and discussed first on the agenda.

Proposed Ordinance Reinstating the Operation and Enforcement of Chapter 5.34 LFPMC, which Restricts the Use of Plastic Bags and Non-compostable Food Service Containers, and Amending LFPMC 5.34.060 Decreasing the Pass-through Charge for Recyclable Paper Bags

Council Chair Tom French introduced item and Council reviewed and discussed the proposed draft ordinance. It was noted that this item will be scheduled for further discussion at the August 12, 2021 regular Council meeting.

First review of applications for PRO and CON committees relating to Lake Forest Park Proposition 1

Deputy Mayor Kassover noted the City has received five (5) applications for the PRO and CON committees—3 PRO and 2 CON. She noted that she has received three (3) additional names who have expressed interest on serving on the PRO committee. 
