

Kirkland Tree Rebate Program



- City of Kirkland provides rebates of up to \$150 per tree and \$500 per property for planting approved trees in 2021. The rebates are funded by a grant from the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)
- Process:
 - Online tree planting course: importance of trees, benefits, choosing
 - Maintenance agreement plus a surface water management agreement
 - Purchase and plant
 - Submit rebate form plus W-9, photo of tree, proof of payment, nursery tag

Kirkland Tree Rebate Program



- Program requirements
 - **Eligibility:** within Kirkland city limits; on owner's private property; voluntary; not for replacement of existing tree
 - **Tree:** meets definition of a tree; selected from Washington Department of Ecology Stormwater Trees list; some trees not eligible
 - **Rebate:** limited to \$150/tree and \$500/property; covers cost of trees, soil amendments, mulch; must take and pass online tree planting course, submit signed maintenance agreement
 - **Planting:** owner responsible for planting in appropriate place; responsible for following care and best practices (City of Kirkland PDFs)
