Passport Services – The Basics of ID2020 Washington

When REAL ID goes into effect in October 2020, you'll need more than a driver's license to fly. Options include a passport, an enhanced driver's license (EDL), green card, and many others. Go to www.ID2020WA.com to find out if you're ready for October 2020.

Don't fly? You're covered. A REAL ID compliant-ID is not required to access federal courts, Social Security offices, national parks, and health care facilities—among others. Other avenues of travel, such as driving across state lines or taking a train do not require a compliant REAL ID. Standard driver's licenses and ID cards will work.
