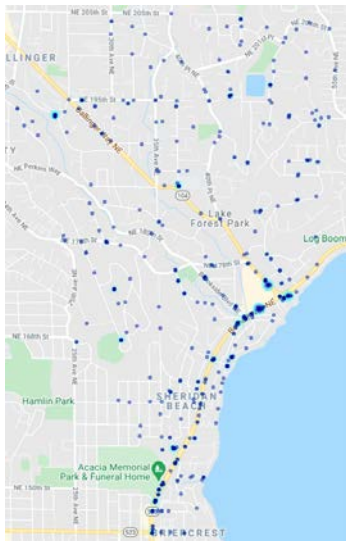

Police incidents heatmap for July 2021:

Each blue dot is an incident generated by dispatch or an officer. This map represents **777** incidents in **July**.

Notable Incidents:

Officers responded to multiple welfare checks of people in crisis or experiencing homelessness. Services were offered to all subject who refused and left the area.

Several new laws went into effect on July 25. The majority were already common practice and in effect in LFP for years. Officers were given training and are adjusting to the changes.

A subject inside a stolen vehicle was contacted by officers. The subject fled at a high rate of speed, nearly striking a child. Officers were unable to pursue vehicle due to new legislation prohibiting it.

National Night Out

National Night Out in Lake Forest Park was the evening of August 3. Nearly 1,000 LFP residents participated in the National Night Out Against Crime. There were over 30 block parties spread out across the city. These events were attended by department staff and city leadership, including the Police Chief, Mayor Johnson, Lieutenants, Patrol Sergeants, Patrol Officers, and Fire Department personnel.
